¹ The right of portability is the right of the data subject to obtain, under certain conditions, personal data concerning him/her which he/she has provided to a controller in a structured, commonly used and machine-readable format and to transmit those data to another controller without hindrance from the original controller. At the same time, the data subject shall also have the right, if he/she so requests, to have his/her personal data transmitted by the controller to another controller in a structured, commonly used and machine-readable format, where technically feasible.

Common conditions for the application of the right of data portability:

- the processing must be based on legal grounds of consent or contract,
- the processing is carried out by automated means.

The exercising of the right of portability must not adversely affect the rights and freedoms of others.

In accordance with Article 12(3) of the EU Regulation, the Company is obliged to inform you free of charge of the measures taken without undue delay and in any case within one month of receipt of the request. This period may be extended by a further two months if necessary and in view of the complexity and number of requests. The Company shall inform you of any such extension within one month of receipt of the request, together with the reasons for the delay.

Pursuant to Article 12(4) of the EU Regulation, if the Company does not comply with your request, it will inform you without delay (within one month at the latest) of the reasons for non-compliance and of the possibility to file a complaint with the supervisory authority (Office for Personal Data Protection, Pplk. Sochora 27, 170 00 Prague 7) and to seek judicial protection.

In accordance with Article 12(5) of the EU Regulation, the Company is not obliged to grant your request in whole or in part if the request is manifestly unfounded or unreasonable, in particular because it keeps repeating. In such cases, the Company may:

- (i) charge a reasonable fee taking into account administrative costs; or
- (ii) refuse to grant the request.

In accordance with Article 12(6) of the EU Regulation, if the Company has reasonable doubt about the identity of the sender of the request, it may ask you to provide additional information necessary to confirm your identity.
